Content:

The course will cover the following topics:

- Definition of adult safeguarding
- Understanding what is meant by the term 'an adult at risk'
- Identifying the nature/extent of abuse
- Outlining the different categories of abuse
- Equipping participants with the knowledge of their role and responsibilities in regards to safeguarding for their organisation and providing them with the knowledge to confidently make a referral
- An overview of the latest DBS guidance
- Scenarios to consolidate learning.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of the sessions participants will be able to:

1. Demonstrate an understanding of who is an adult at risk
2. Understand what safeguarding adults means
3. Identify different types of abuse
4. Be able to recognise situations where abuse is taking place, or is suspected to be taking place
5. Demonstrate confidence in how to effectively report and record a safeguarding concern
6. Understand what is meant by the term mental capacity.

All attendees will receive a certificate of attendance.

Volunteers or Volunteer managers working with Bury based Volunteer, Community & Faith organisations who provide support, information advice and guidance or activities to adults on a regular basis.
