Our charitable purpose



ADVOCACY



Mobilising and encouraging community action, strengthening our sector's voice and influence on key decision-makers and funders. Our role is to champion the voice of the sector and create positive change through coordinating and facilitating collaboration with partners from the VCSE, public and private sectors in Bury.

This includes a range of thematic networks and involvement in strategic partnerships to strengthen the voice of the VCSE sector.

PARTNERSHIPS AND COLLABORATIONS



Creating opportunities and driving effective joint working by building networks of local organisations and strategic partners. We work in partnership with a range of organisations to deliver projects including the Violence Reduction Community-Led Alliance, the Beacon Social Prescribing and Housing Welfare Programmes, LGBT Project and Food Aid to Food Trade programme.

We deliver a range of grants programmes on behalf of Bury Council including Standing Together, Hate Crime Awareness, Cost of Living Grants and Local Pilot Community Investments.

CAPACITY BUILDING



Providing practical support and opportunities for people to develop skills in their local community, so that they can achieve their goals and aspirations.

Our capacity building offer covers a range of topics including new start-up for groups, governance, funding, financial management, safeguarding, publicity and social media.

We provide 1 -1 support as well as a range of training and learning opportunities to build skills around organisational and volunteer management and trusteeship.

Building an environment in which volunteers and their communities thrive, by encouraging and nurturing volunteering opportunities. We help individuals looking for volunteer opportunities and provide good practice support to groups and organisations who involve volunteers.

Enable new approaches to employer supported volunteering to maximise opportunities for people to give their time and skills through their employer.
