Cyber-Crime

If you work with children and young people you need to have an understanding of how they can be groomed into cyber-crime. This is particularly important now as they are spending more time on their computers.

This session will give you:

- **Information to prevent young people from becoming involved in Cyber Crime and how to use their computer skills positively**
